**When:** Saturday, June 22, 2002. Registration opens 6:30am; closes 15 minutes before each race. Registration age 14 and under opens 7:30am.

**Where:** Registration and start at Pescadero High School on Butano Cut-Off Rd. Take Pescadero Rd. inland from Hwy. 1 about 3 miles; turn right onto Cloverdale, then left onto Butano Cut-off; high school will be on the left. Pescadero Rd. is about 21 miles south of Hwy. 92 at Half Moon Bay and about 7 miles south of Hwy. 84 at San Gregorio.

**Course:** Spectacular 28-mile loop through coastal dunes and redwood groves consisting of Stage Rd., Hwy. 84, and Pescadero Rd. 1500' of climbing per lap including the epic Haskin's Hill grade. Start with 2-mile promenade from high school to intersection of North St. and Stage Rd. Then wind up for the big cash prime before the first climb on Stage Rd. Use caution on descents - pavement is poor and mossy in places and descents are steep and twisty. Good to fair pavement otherwise. Feed zone located after right turn onto Pescadero Rd. from Hwy. 84 (17 miles from start).

**Rules:** Held rain or shine. This is a USCF insured event held under USCF racing rules. USCF license required. One-day licenses may be purchased at registration for \$5. Please respect local residents and warm up on trainer or rollers; if warming up on the road, stay to the right. Center line rule enforced.

**Swap Meet:** Bring your new and used equipment to buy, sell, or trade with other riders after the race.
