A Benefit for South Coast Children's Services

When: Saturday, June 13, 2009. Registration opens 7:00am; closes 15 minutes before each race.

Where: Reg/start at Pescadero High School on Butano Cut-Off Rd. Take Pescadero Rd. inland from Hwy.1 about 3 miles; turn right onto Cloverdale, then left onto Butano Cut-Off. Pescadero is between Half Moon Bay and Santa Cruz.

Course: Spectacular 28-mile loop through coastal dunes and redwood groves consisting of Stage Rd., Hwy.84 and Pescadero Rd. 1500' of climbing per lap including the epic Haskin's Hill grade. Start with promenade from High School to Pescadero town center. Then wind up for the big sprint prime before the first climb on Stage. Use caution on the steep and twisty descents. Fair to good pavement. Feed zone located after right turn onto Pescadero Rd. from Hwy. 84. Finish at top of Haskins Hill. Cars NOT allowed at the finish line or along Stage Rd. Do NOT drive to the finish line (your rider will be subject to disqualification). To reach Feed Zone, use Hwys.1 and 84 (not Stage or Pescadero Rds.).

Fee includes \$2 USCF and \$1 NCNCA insurance surcharges. There will be an additional online registration surcharge. Race-day registration, add \$5. No mail-in registration this year. Current NCNCA road champions race for \$10 if entry is done online and is in category of championship (masters may race down; pay full amount up front and receive refund at check-in). \$5 of entry fee goes to South Coast Children's Services (tax-deductible contribution). Sorry, no refunds.

Rules: Held rain or shine. This is a USA Cycling-insured event held under USA Cycling event permit. USCF license required. One-day licenses may be purchased at registration for \$10. Be respectful and courteous to the locals at all times; we are guests in their neighborhood. Follow the rules of the road while warming up. Centerline rule enforced. Do not litter. Use portapotties.
